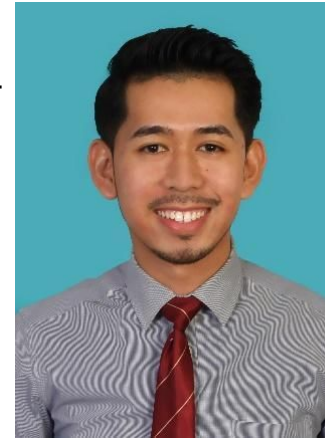

Recently in September, I was selected to represent Brunei for an Asean+3 Youth Environmental Forum (AYEF 2019) in Thailand.

In July 2019, I was selected as the final 90 delegates out of 9200 applicants to represent Brunei in an International Model Diplomacy Simulation in Qatar organized by ICYF (Islamic Corporation Youth Forum) and the government of Qatar to discuss and present our view on Good Governance and Transparency among Youth, Youth Empowerment in UN sustainable development goals, and Diplomacy.
