Prior to Arrival

Make sure you have prepared all the necessary documentation required to visit Qatar, including:

Hayya Card

All international fans will need a [Hayya Card to enter Qatar](#), as it will serve as your visa.

It provides entry to a stadium (with a valid match ticket), access to public transport on match days and smart journey planning (via the Hayya app).



Accommodation

Please book your accommodation through the [Qatar Accommodation Agency 2022](#) platform. Bookings are linked to the Hayya Card for entry visa validation.



Ehteraz

Travellers should download the Ehteraz app prior to arrival. It is Qatar's [COVID-19 monitoring app](#). Currently, all ticketholders are required to be fully vaccinated.

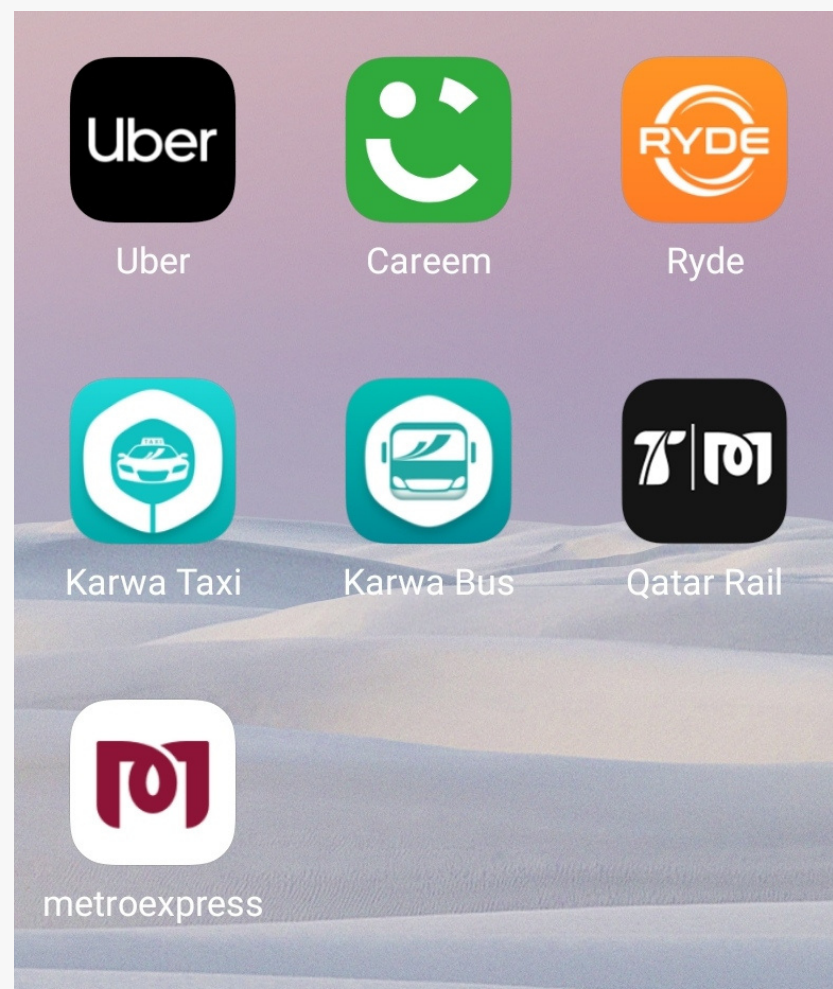
